The Final Programme booklet will be distributed onsite at the meeting in Basel.

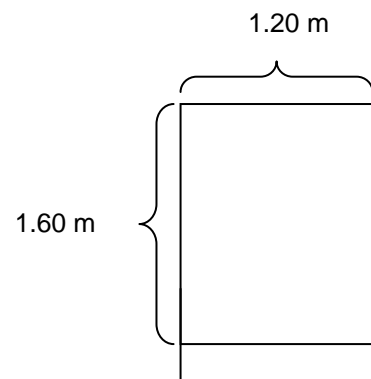
The pre-requisite for a successful poster is good visual presentation, so that your work arouses interest! This can best be achieved by observing the following guidelines:

1. Max. poster size (**VERTICAL PRESENTATION**):

- width: **1.20 m / 47.637 inches**
- height: **1.60 m / 62.992 inches**

2. We suggest you design your poster layout in the following sections:

- Title, author, address (on the upper edge, across the width of the whole poster)
- Introduction and Purpose
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusions



3. The title should be emphasised by the use of a bold type face. This writing should be easily readable at a distance of 2 – 3 meters.

4. The text can be broken up by the inclusion of drawings and/or photos.

5. To promote your work we suggest you bring handouts for distribution to interested delegates.
